Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The NZEI has advised the Fairfield Primary School Board of Trustees that New Zealand's principals and primary teachers have voted for a second strike. There will be nationwide rolling strikes over a week, and our region will be striking on **Tuesday 13th November**.

The Board has carefully considered the availability of teaching staff, and decided that we can't provide the normal teaching services during this strike, therefore **our school will be closed on this date**.

**School will not be open on Tuesday 13th November. There will be no supervision available for students.**

While we regret the inconvenience we know this will cause, we support our principal and teachers in sending a clear message to the Government that we are standing strong for our students.

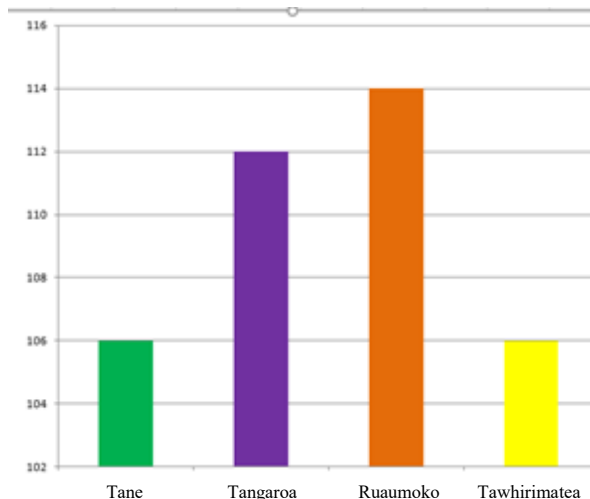
