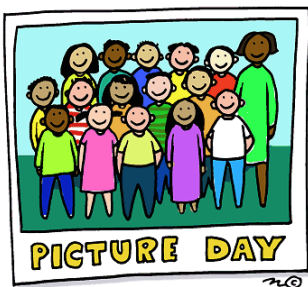
PHOTO DAY
