OUT-OF-ZONE VACANCIES Term 1 2022

The board advises that a number of vacancies have become available at Fairfield Primary School for Term 1 2022. (2nd February -14th April 2022)

Since the last ballot for out-of-zone places on 25th October 2021 the board has received a number of enquiries from parents of out-of-zone students seeking to enrol their children at the school.

Because the board operates an enrolment scheme, it is required to fill any vacant out-of-zone places by ballot. The board has determined that 16 places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students for enrolment from 2nd February 2022. The exact number of places in each year level will depend on the number of applications received from students who live in zone.

The board is prepared to receive applications, in addition to those it already holds, so long as they reach the school by 25th January 2022. If a ballot is required it will be held on 28th January 2022.

Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.
