Referrals to other agencies

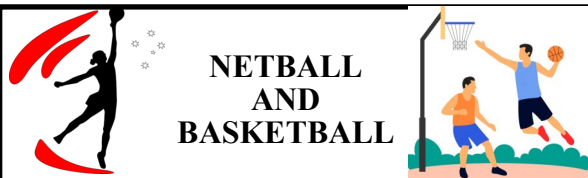

ENROLMENT AT FAIRFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL FOR NEW STUDENTS

The Fairfield Primary School Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their children at Fairfield Primary School for the period:

24th April – 30th June (Term 2 2023)

Enrolment at the school is governed by an Enrolment Scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

The Board has determined that a total of 6 places are likely to be available for **OUT OF ZONE** students in Years 1 – 6.

The exact number of places in each year level will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's enrolment zone.

Application forms are available from the school office.

The deadline for receipt of application for Out of Zone places is: 31st March 2023.

Parents who live within the home zone and who intend enrolling their child in Term 2 should notify the school office by 31st March to assist the school in planning appropriately for this period. All students in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school. The ballot only affects students who live out of zone.

If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available in each year level, students will be selected by ballot.

If a ballot for out of zone places is required, it will be held on 4th April 2023. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.
