The cut-off for return of permission slips is 9:00am next Thursday 4th April.

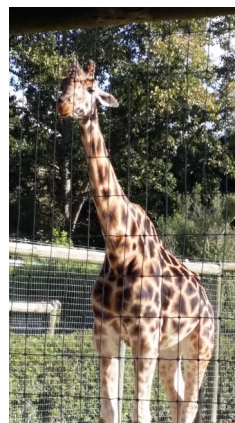
## Football Skills Sessions
