2025 OUT-OF-ZONE BALLOT INFORMATION



Enrolment at Fairfield Primary School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

The board has determined 10 places are likely to be available for out-of-zone students in 2025. The exact number of places in each year level will depend on the number of applications received from students who live in zone.

There will be 4 enrolment periods in 2025 providing there are places available. The first enrolment period is for Term 1 (30th January to 11th April).

If you live out-of-zone and you wish for your child to be considered for enrolment for Term 1 2024 through the out-of-zone ballot, you will need to complete an application form. Application forms are available from the school office or can be emailed upon request.
