Rooms 8,9,10,12,15 & 16 are off to the lake on Wednesday 4th December—weather permitting.

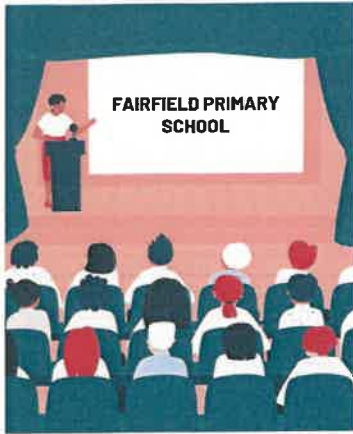
Consent/health forms have already been sent home and must be returned to enable your child to go.
